In accordance with the current NSD Officially Approved Dance Rules, pre-registration is required. **Pre-registration forms must be postmarked (or emailed) by August 9, 2024.**

- 1. For dances with only one entrant, registrants will be notified and offered the opportunity to perform an exhibition. In addition, late registrants would be welcome up until 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the dance.
- 2. For dances with two entrants, the competition will be held. Late registrants would also be welcome up until 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the dance to upgrade the event to a sanctioned competition.
- 3. Dances without pre-registrants will be cancelled without the opportunity to be re-opened

Dance competitions are "closed" and are thus open only to NSD Members who are in good standing in accordance with NSD Officially Approved Dance Rules. Dancers must be amateurs (and not professionals), must purchase the complete "Package Deal," and must sign releases on the Competition Registration form in order to be allowed to compete. Please consult your chapter's Dance Rules Chairperson or review the latest NSD dance rules **for information on proper attire and dance tempos.**

You are advised to send in your competition registration and package deal convention registration early to avoid missing the deadline.

The following are excerpts from NSD Dance Rules meant to assist persons who wish to compete at the 2024 Convention. Although care has been taken to insure accuracy, this information is not a substitute for the official NSD Dance Rules or any portion thereof. If any conflict should arise, the official NSD Dance Rules in effect at the time of the Convention shall prevail. You are advised to consult your chapter's Dance Rules Chairman for further information or clarifications.

A. Tempo of Music The tempo of music shall be in accordance with that suggested by recognized amateur societies and shall be stated in terms of measures per minute (mpm).

- **C. Duration of Dances.** The duration of any single dance within a sanctioned competition shall be limited to 90 seconds. If any judge has not completed making the dancers within that time, an additional 30 seconds may be run his or her request.
- **D. Lifts** Lifts are allowed only when the feet of the lifted dancer do not come above the waist of the partner doing the lifting. A lift is defined as a movement during which one dancer is supported by the partner and has both feet off the floor at the same time.

E. Attire Dress for all approved competitions, preliminaries, semi-finals and finals shall be of the appropriate formal mode for the Division.

1. International Standard Division

One-Star - Semi-formal attire suggested, costumes optional.

Two-Star - Ball gown or Gown for ladies; Vest, Tuxedo or Tails for gentlemen
Three-Star - Ball gown or Gown for ladies; Vest, Tuxedo or Tails for gentlemen

Four-Star - Ball gowns for ladies; Tuxedo or Tails for gentlemen

2. International Latin/American Rhythm Division

One-Star

Ladies: Dress or Skirt & Top.. No Gowns or Costumes. Gentlemen: Shirt

& Slacks (Vest may be added).

Two Star/Three Star/Four Star

Ladies: Dress or Skirt & Top. Gentlemen: Shirt & Slacks. (Vest may be

added). Latin attire permitted for both ladies & gentlemen

3. American Smooth Division

Ladies: Dress or Skirt & Top or Blouse, or Unadorned Palazzo Pants &

One Star Top. No Gowns or Costumes. Gentlemen: Slacks, Shirt & tie (Vest not

permitted.)

Ladies: Dress or Skirt & Top or Blouse, Cocktail Dress, or Unadorned

Two Star Palazzo Pants & Top. No Gowns or Costumes. Gentlemen: Slacks, Shirt

& tie (Vest may be added).

Formal dress, length below knee and above ankle, no exposed midriff -

Three Star/ Four Star Nude Illusion is acceptable or Ball gown for ladies: Gentleman: Tuxedo,

Tails, or Slacks Shirt & Vest with Tie.
